Section VII CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

I PURPOSE

- A. To develop a method for individuals to rank themselves against other residents in the State of Florida.
- B. By the accumulation of points (over a period of one year) in single and/or double events, at sanctioned FDA tournaments, the Florida Dart Association sanctioned itself to “declare” a “State Champion” in the single events category.
- C. By this accumulation of points, the FDA only makes a declaration of such, to the person; this declaration does not signify an individuals’ shooting ability in a specific FDA sanctioned tournament.

II FDA STATISTICIAN

- A. All championship points are tabulated by the FDA Statistician.
- B. The Statistician reports monthly to the President and at least quarterly on the results of his tabulation to the full board. The results will be posted on the FDA Website.
- C. The Florida Darts Association Statistician is appointed by the Board of Directors and is a member of the Executive Board.

III ELIGIBILITY

- A. Only FDA members domiciled (unless active military duty) in Florida are eligible to receive championship points.
- B. To receive points a person must be an FDA member in one of the following ways:
 - 1. An active member of a FDA member association.
 - 2. Individual annual member.
 - 3. Lifetime member.
- C. Weekend members are not eligible.

IV METHOD

- A. Persons receive championship points by finishing in the top eight of any FDA sanctioned tournament, in any of the following events:
 - 1. Open singles-men’s or ladies.
 - 2. Open doubles-men’s or ladies.
 - 3. Mixed Doubles.
 - 4. In addition, a person who finishes in the top sixteen of a \$15,000.00 total payout tournament will receive points.
- B. The points received for a doubles event will be split equally between the two players.
- C. Women who earn points in the open events will be listed in the Open Standings, only those points earned in ladies events will be added to their total on the Ladies standings sheet.

- D. The Area Representative of the Association sponsoring the tournament must compile the awarded points and forward those results to the FDA Statistician with two weeks after the tournament has ended.
- E. The tabulation of points must be on the official FDA tournament results form.
- F. It is important that the number of entries or teams be included for each event, as it is necessary in figuring the championship points.

V OTHER METHODS

- A. FDA Championship singles points for State Team will be awarded in accordance with the rules set forth in Section IV, X., F...
- B. Any FDA Member who competes in an ADO Regional for Region IV-5 will receive one singles point for participation and one singles point for each match won.

VI POINT SYSTEM

- A. Point awards will be made in accordance with the following structure.
- B. Championship Points are not retroactive.
- C. Point values are based upon the number of entries and the total prize money in the tournament....see "Prize Money Impact".

D. Prize Money Impact

<u>Total Prize Money</u>	<u>Point Values</u>	<u>Awarded To</u>
\$1,000-\$4,999	Divided by 4	Top 8
\$5,000-\$9,999	Divided by 2	Top 8
\$10,000-\$14,999	Full Pt. Value	Top 8
\$15,000-Up	Multiply by 1.5	Top 16

- E. Total prize money winnings by an individual during a given year have no effect on this system.

V OTHER AWARDS

- A. Each man and lady that accumulates the most single points in a given year will receive a plaque declaring them the "Individual State Champion".
- B. They each shall also receive \$300.00.
- C. The winner in each division shall receive an embroidered shirt of their choice, valued up to \$40.00, proclaiming them that year's "State Champion".
